

Volunteering Policy for the Ogilvy exhibition

PSEC considers it an honour to hold its annual juried show at Ogilvy's. However it is a challenge every year to find enough volunteers for the various tasks required during the 10 day exhibition. this represents 36 persons to fill 18 spots for "sitting", as well as the committees to be established for the following activities : the reception of the works, the hanging, the daily demonstrations, the vernissage, the Café des artistes and the take-down.

To cover all the tasks we need each participant (with the exception of those living far away) to accomplish two tasks just as it has always been. However from now on, this policy will be associated with our participation policy and will be written on the Conditions sheet, inviting the members to participate in the Ogilvy exhibition (as opposed to receiving the volunteer availability sheet only once accepted into the show as was the case in the past) .

This procedure will be fairer for all the participants and less problematic for the volunteers of the organizing committee who, from their point of view after having worked all year, expect the participants to demonstrate their good will at the time of the exhibition.

To help compensate all persons having covered two tasks, we will continue our practice of reimbursing the hanging fees of \$5 per painting.

As many of our members reside in far away regions, a radius of 150 km from Montreal has been adopted as the travel distance for participants.
