POLICY

PSEC offers its members the opportunity to have their work better known to the public during the exhibitions. The 4 (four) following albums are made available to visitors:

- Regular Members;
- Signature Members;
- Teaching Members;
- PSEC Masters.

Many visitors like to spend time studying these albums. Also, if need be, the members on duty at the exhibition can refer to them to answer questions from the public or to provide references about artists who teach pastel.

PROCEDURES

To have their information added to any of these albums, PSEC members may submit their CV by email. However, they must send their pictures by **regular mail** to ensure the desired quality of reproduction. They must send them to the person from PSEC responsible for updating them, **Line Hamel**: line.hamel@pastelsec.com

Note that every year, all references older than 5 years are removed from these albums.

Adding photos allows teaching members to illustrate their fields of interest, such as still life, portraiture, etc. (Their CV is shown in the Members' Album).	6 (six) pages 8½ x 11 in. (two-sided) as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Page 1 (both sides): Your CV • Page 2 to 6 (both sides): your pictures. If your CV only covers one side of page 1, you can add pictures on the back of this page, in addition to the front and back of the other 5 pages.
